Teacher chapter book read aloud could include:

The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe, Three Tales of My Father's Dragon, Esio Trot, Mrs. Piggle Wiggle, Beatrix Potter, The Mouse and the Motorcycle, The Cricket in Times' Square, Stuart Little, Helen Keller, Louis Braille, Neal Armstrong, The Trumpet of the Swan.

Student's progress through a series of phonetic readers at their own pace, individually progressing to other books as each student is ready.

We read a wide variety of outstanding literature to the children daily.

We read and learn poetry from: *A New Treasury of Children's Poetry*.

We thoroughly cement the foundations of spelling and reading by learning the vowels and consonants, the sounds they make and how to mark them (phonograms 1-26) and then continue with consonant blends, sight words and multi-letter phonograms. We participate in ear training activities and games to enhance auditory memory and to reinforce listening and pre-reading skills. We use D'Nealian handwriting and learn to write each letter as the phonogram is introduced.

In Math we use Saxon Math 1 with lots of manipulatives.

We spend 20-30 minutes outside everyday, weather permitting and have snacks everyday.

Two days a week will include 60 minutes of center time where the children may choose activities to do according to their individual preference. You will be asked to be a parent helper during these center times.
